*Acts 2, pp. 908 - 909*

1. The Holy Spirit comes \_\_\_\_\_. (v. 1-13)
  - Uneducated disciples speak in numerous languages.
  - Foreigners hear clearly in their mother tongue.
  - Prophecy from Joel 2:28-32 is fulfilled.
  
2. Peter preaches that Jesus is both \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_. (v. 14-36)
  - Jesus was accredited by God by miracles, signs and wonders.
  - Put to death, buried, but raised by God from the dead.
  - He is the fulfillment of David's promises. (v. 29-31)
  - Jesus is alive and has poured out the Holy Spirit.
  
3. Three thousand respond to Peter's sermon. (v. 37-40)
  - They \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus is both Lord and Christ.
  - They \_\_\_\_\_ of being lord of their own lives.
  - They are \_\_\_\_\_ into Christ.
    - ~ Their sins are forgiven.
    - ~ They receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

4. Peter quotes prophecy from Joel (v. 17-21) as well as from Psalm 16. What role do you see prophecy playing for followers of Jesus?
5. According to Acts 2:36-38, who should be baptized into Christ?
